



INFORMATION FOR NWT ARCHAEOLOGISTS PERMIT APPLICANTS

NWT Archaeologist Permit applicants may need other permits, licenses, or permissions to conduct research in the NWT. It is the permit applicant's responsibility to ensure that they have all required permits, licenses, and permissions.
