

Support to Northern Performers Program

This program helps promote and develop northern performing arts by providing financial contributions for the performances of NWT performing artists at festivals and events occurring in the Northwest Territories.

Eligibility

- Groups or organizations registered in the NWT which intend to carry out a festival or event promoting the performing arts in the NWT.
- Eligible costs include, but are not limited to performance fees, travel, food, accommodation and administrative or production costs not exceeding 10% of your total budget.

Application Procedures

A funding proposal must be submitted. Proposals should be 3 pages maximum. Two letters of support are also required.

Include the following information in your proposal:

Written Proposal

- the goals and objectives of presenting NWT performing artists at your festival or event
 - a work schedule for organizing the performing arts portion of your festival
 - a proposed schedule of performances, workshops and other arts presentations during your festival or event

Budget Proposal

- a detailed budget breakdown for the performing arts portion of your project
- amount of contribution applied for

- list all funding from other sources that you will be receiving or that you have applied for.

Letters of Support

- provide two letters of support for your festival or event from recognized community members or organizations.

Review

Applicants are notified of decisions in writing following the review process, which may require 6 to 8 weeks or more after the deadline.

Deadline for Submissions

The deadline is **March 31** each year. Proposals must be postmarked, faxed or delivered by the deadline.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Funding proposals should be three pages maximum. Include the following information in your funding proposal:

<i>Background:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• name of group or organization• address• phone and fax numbers• name of contact person• name of festival or event• date and location
<i>Objectives:</i>	Goals and objectives of presenting NWT performing artists at your festival or event
<i>Performers:</i>	The number (and names if possible) of NWT performing artists to be featured at the festival or event
<i>Work Schedule:</i>	A work schedule for organizing the performing arts portion of the festival or event
<i>Performance Schedule:</i>	A proposed schedule of performances, workshops and other arts presentations during the festival or event
<i>Budget:</i>	A detailed budget breakdown for the performing arts portion of your festival or event. Include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• amount of contribution applied for• funding from other sources that you will be receiving or that you have applied for
<i>Letters of Support:</i>	Provide two letters of support for your festival or event from recognized community members or organizations
